

## What Goes in the Recycling?

### PAPER PRODUCTS

- corrugated cardboard & paper boxes  
*large or multiple pieces should be flattened and/or cut*
- shredded paper  
*in a paper bag, secured with a staple*
- junk mail
- newspaper
- phonebooks & catalogs
- dairy cartons
- aseptic boxes  
*juice, soup & soy milk*
- books up to 40 lbs.

### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

### ALUMINUM & METAL

- aerosol cans (*empty*)
- cans & pans
- scrap pieces up to 20 lbs.

### PLASTICS LABELED ♻️

- bottles & jars
- tubs & trays
- plastic bags  
*Protect the environment by avoiding single-use bags. Reuse them when possible. When recycling multiple bags, stuff one bag full of the others; tie off the full bag before placing in the recycling.*
