

RESOLUTION NO. 2008- 08

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
PERTAINING TO THE USE OF PREFERENTIAL PARKING FEES PURSUANT TO
THE LOS ALTOS MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 8.20.111**

WHEREAS, Los Altos Municipal Code ("LAMC") Sections 8.20.110 through 8.20.112 govern the City's preferential parking program ("PPP") and provide for the use of the revenue generated by the fees from such a program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the Downtown PPP in 2003 and since the implementation of the Downtown PPP all of the revenues generated from it have been deposited into a separate downtown parking fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the revenue generated by the fees from the Downtown PPP may be used to enhance and protect the quality of life in the downtown business area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds and authorizes the following:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes \$20,000 from the Downtown PPP fund to be used by the Los Altos Village Association ("LAVA") for the public improvements outlined in this resolution.
2. The City Council finds that the use of the Downtown PPP funds as outlined in this resolution benefit the City by enhancing and protecting the quality of life in the downtown area by providing public improvements (beautification and maintenance projects) such as landscaping, trash and litter removal and sidewalk cleaning in any public place within the downtown business area or in the general area where the funds are raised.
3. The amount of \$20,000 will be used by LAVA to provide the specific public improvements as described in LAVA's memorandum attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by this reference. The public improvements include the following:
 - (a) Flowers, flower pots, soil
 - (b) Sidewalk cleaning six (6) times per year
 - (c) Debris pickup on Main, State and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Streets
 - (d) Purchase of sidewalk trash containers
4. The Downtown PPP funds shall not be used for any LAVA administrative functions including, but not limited to, overhead charges, salaries, rent or lease costs, administrative

fees or any other expenditures not directly related to the City or the downtown business area.

5. Per LAMC Section 8.20.111(e) and within sixty (60) days of the completion of the projects, LAVA shall provide to the City Council a detailed accounting of the use of said funds and any unused funds shall be returned to the City within said sixty (60) day time period.
6. LAVA shall not be entitled to additional Downtown PPP funds until the projects have been completed and the accounting has been provided to and accepted by the City Council.
7. This resolution shall be effective and enforceable after February 26, 2008.
