

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS DEEMING CERTAIN PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT OF THE CITY TO BE "SURPLUS" PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE TO THE PUBLIC AND/OR ITS DONATION OR DESTRUCTION

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 37350 provides that a city may purchase, lease, receive, hold, and enjoy real and personal property, and control and dispose of it for the common benefit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council shall approve City property and/or equipment that is to be "surplused" because it has exhausted its useful life ("Surplus Property"); and

WHEREAS, such Surplus Property may be transferred to another City department, sold to another governmental agency, disposed of at a public auction, sold through competitive bids, or donated to: (1) other public entities (domestic/foreign); (2) any other city; or (3) to non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that certain playground equipment (Whistle Stop Train) has exhausted its useful life upon the renovations of the City's Whistle Stop playground; and


WHEREAS, no City department has indicated a desire for the playground equipment (Whistle Stop Train); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The following findings are made by the City Council of the City of Los Altos:
 - a. The City playground equipment (Whistle Stop Train) is hereby deemed to be Surplus Property pursuant to Government Code section 37350.
 - b. The City may sell by public auction the Surplus Property (Whistle Stop Train).
 - c. If the Surplus Property (Whistle Stop Train) does not sell by public auction within thirty (30) days, the City may thereafter dispose of said Surplus Property (Whistle Stop Train) by donation or destruction.
