**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR
(TFCA) 40% FUNDS WITH THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW TO UPDATE THE
TRAFFIC SIGNAL INTERCONNECT SYSTEM ON GRANT ROAD**

WHEREAS, an interconnect system on Grant Road between Bentley Square in Mountain View and Oak Avenue in Los Altos would reduce air pollution, reduce traffic congestion and decrease emergency vehicle response time; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) has made funding available to local agencies for projects which reduce air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority has been delegated the responsibility for processing applications and recommending projects to the BAAQMD for Santa Clara County; and

WHEREAS, the BAAQMD will make the final selection of projects from a combined list of recommended projects from nine bay area counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Los Altos:


Supports the application for Transportation Fund for clean air (TFCA) 40% Funds and authorize staff to enter into a cost sharing agreement with the City of Mountain View to update the traffic signal interconnect system on Grant Road.
