**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NON-COMPETITIVE
FUNDS FROM SANTA CLARA COUNTY UNDER THE FEDERAL HOUSING
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001/2002**

WHEREAS, the City of Los Altos has previously entered into a Joint Powers Agreement with Santa Clara County to form an Urban County under the Housing and Community Development Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held duly noticed public hearings on February 27, 2001 and March 27, 2001 on the allocation of funds under the Community Development Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the following proposals represent the community development needs in Los Altos;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that staff is hereby authorized to submit proposals for the expenditures of CDBG funds in the amount of \$180,874 as described below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the final 2001/2002 CDBG funding allocations are provisioned as follows:

- 1) That the City's CDBG program is fully funded by the federal government;
- 2) That any unspent capital project funding shall be returned to the City; and
- 3) That the capital projects allocation \$109,207 to the Low-Income Housing Fund will be reconsidered after December 31, 2001 to determine the potential of a future CDBG-eligible housing project in Los Altos.

BE IT ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute standard CDBG contracts between the City and the non-profit agencies for Fiscal Year 2001/2002.
