

RESOLUTION NO. 01-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
AMENDING THE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX RATE FOR
FISCAL YEARS 2001-2002

WHEREAS, the City Council submitted an ordinance to the voters to authorize an increase in the transient occupancy tax;

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 6, 2001 the voters approved an increase in the transient occupancy tax from 8% to a maximum of 11%;

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that each year, following adoption of the City's budget, the City Council will determine the rate to be charged for the transient occupancy tax, and shall set that rate in an amount not to exceed the rate authorized by the ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the budget on June 26, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that:

1. The City Council adopts an increase in the transient occupancy tax from 8% to 10%; and
2. The City Council adopts this increase to fund operational expenses in the current fiscal year 2001-2001 budget;
