

**RESOLUTION NO. 00-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NON-COMPETITIVE  
FUNDS FROM SANTA CLARA COUNTY UNDER THE FEDERAL HOUSING  
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000/2001**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Los Altos has previously entered into a Joint Powers Agreement with Santa Clara County to form an Urban County under the Housing and Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held duly noticed public hearings on February 29, 2000 and March 14, 2000 on the allocation of funds under the Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the following proposals represent the community development needs in Los Altos;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that staff is hereby authorized to submit proposals for the expenditures of CDBG funds in the amount of \$166,478 as described below:


