

RESOLUTION NO. 00-20  
A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH COST SHARING  
OBLIGATIONS BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS AND THE  
STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE  
SEQUOIA FIRE STATION

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Los Altos, Santa Clara County, California,  
that

WHEREAS, the Sequoia Fire Station located at 10 Almond Avenue in the City of Los Altos was determined to be in need of seismic upgrading and an application for funding such upgrading was submitted to the State of California, and this application was approved, and

WHEREAS, a contract for seismic upgrading and other renovation work has been completed by KAL Construction at a total cost of \$368,666, and

WHEREAS, the cost of all the work related to the seismic upgrading has been determined to be in excess of \$213,654 and

WHEREAS, the terms of the grant from the State require the City to pay 25% of the seismic upgrading costs, which would be \$71,218, and the State to pay the remaining 75%, up to a maximum reimbursement of \$213,654, and

WHEREAS, City is willing to pay said 25% share and all other non-seismic project costs;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. The City of Los Altos agrees to pay \$71,218 as its share of seismic upgrading cost for the Sequoia Fire Station and to pay all other non-seismic project costs.
2. The City of Los Altos agrees to accept \$213,654 as the State of California's 75% share of the seismic upgrading costs.
3. The City Manager, Phil Rose, is the individual authorized to sign as agent for the City of Los Altos.
