and San Francisco Bay.




What you
should know
as a pet
owner...

1 DON'T FLUSH unwanted pet medications of any kind down the toilet or sink. Some medications can't be removed during wastewater treatment and can enter San Francisco Bay causing potential harm to water quality and wildlife.

2 TO PROTECT your family, pets and San Francisco Bay, dispose pet medicines properly at a local collection site (see reverse).

3 FOR MORE INFORMATION about the expiration, use or storage of pet medications ask your veterinarian or pharmacist.
