#### Public Comments:

Jeannie Bruins and Chris Hlavka discussed the diagonal curb cut in the Safe Routes to School Project on the corner of Grant Road and Oak Avenue.

Suzanne Ambiel: provided information about Bicycle Transportation Plans being developed by the Metropolitan Transportation Committee; announced that three Los Altos Schools will be launching Freiker programs [that promote biking to school].

ACTION: mail any additional comments to Kathy. Bicycle signage installation is in progress and the design of Homestead Improvement project will start in February.
