**Discussion:**

1. Minutes of 11/19/08 approved
2. 2009 Goals. The following suggestions were made:
  - School bike education
  - Outreach (Bike to Work Day, community picnic)
  - Review of City projects at 35% design stage
  - Update Bicycle Transportation Plan
  - Generate school commute issues list
  - Survey of pedestrian facilities
  - Review Traffic Calming Toolkit
  - Provide CIP feedback and prioritization
  - Monitor progress on Stevens Creek Trail
3. 2 year budget cycle. CIP prioritization  
Bill C. states that ADA queue is full, no more projects can start so Schedule next meeting.  
Discussion and recommendation for prioritization of ped, bike, ADA projects.
4. W. Portola school commute safety. Tabled.
5. Pedestrian Access along collectors (El Monte). Committee recommends that a comprehensive Pedestrian Master Plan /facilities survey be done rather than piecemeal/squeaky wheel process.
6. Alternative bike rack proposal: referred to Public Sculpture committee.
7. Stevens Creek Trail update: Mountain View, Los Altos, Sunnyvale, Cupertino staff and council members (and Bill C) met in December. Some possibility that Sunnyvale will reconsider SCT. Another meeting scheduled for April, Santa Clara Water Dist to be included?
8. Traffic Commission update: TC made recommendation for striping Campbell btwn Rosita and Cuesta. No recommendation for xwalk at Cuesta/S. Clark
9. VTA: expressway master plan includes pedestrian access along most expressways, with notable exception of Foothill west of Edith.
10. Bike Education: Scott to contact SVBC/Milpitas about middle school training.
11. CIP Update (Kathy)

- Wrong way bike signs: input on sign locations from BPAC has been received and she is working on it.
  - Only \$100k for ADA. Need to postpone some intersection upgrades.
  - Adobe Creek Bridge bid open.
  - Fremont Bridge. Neighborhood group has given input.
  - Safe Routes to School 2005 grant: Addendum to design is waiting to be sent to consultant prior to bidding.
  - Safe Routes to School 2007 grant: Kathy is working on E76 Form (Caltrans permission to fund design).
  - Los Altos Bike Lane : RFP
12. February Meeting canceled due to school vacation. Next meeting March. Agenda items for next meeting : Decide 2009 goals, W. Portola School commute, #7 Stevens Creek Trail, # 8 Traffic Commission update, #9 VTA update, 10 Bike Education, 11 CIP update
