**Discussion:**

1. Minutes of previous meeting
2. Discussion of Bike To Work Day.  
417 total bikes passed station on Foothill Expressway. 121 Eastbound (38 stopped) and 296 westbound (132 stopped). This compares with 358 total (150 stopped) in 2007. Items distributed: mussette bags 150 (5 left over); bananas 5 bunches (0); water 60 bottles (3); raisins 30 (4); oranges 16 (0); coffee cake 120 pc (10). Hobees provided coffee cake, Draeger provided rest of food.
3. Discussion of meeting with City traffic engineer regarding Deodora & Arboretum, bike/car accident 12/23/07. Motion to ask Traffic Commission to ask City Council to direct traffic engineer to study intersection.
4. Discussion of Edith Ave Bridge for Gardner Bullis commute.  
Bridge is divided by Los Altos Hills. Need to understand who owns the bridge.
5. Loyola Corner circulation. Discussion deferred.
6. 1<sup>st</sup> Street improvement/bicycle access. Discussion deferred.

Stevens Creek Trail Feasibility Study update. Alta revised plan based on comments. Mountain View, Sunnyvale, and Cupertino have been sent review copies and asked for comments. Only Mountain View has promised a response. City staff wants comments from other jurisdictions before taking the plan to City Council.

7. Traffic Commission update.  
Briefed about Hawthorne/El Monte traffic calming design proposal.
8. VTA BPAC update.  
San Jose wants to add alternate routes to cross-county bike routes. Stevens Creek Trail and Loyola Bridge bike accommodations are still in the plan.
9. Capital Improvement Plan update.  
Flashing pedestrian crossing lights on San Antonio are not functioning due to defective batteries. Replacements will be installed.  
Dave McNulty, resident of Carmel Terrace, inquired about the CIP project defining a Class I bike path on Carmel Terrace to Blach Intermediate School.
10. Schedule next meeting and Agenda items for next meeting:
