- 1) Minutes of September meeting approved
- 2) Funding of miscellaneous expenses: City will approve reimbursement of banner or other expenses with receipts. Committees can apply for annual budget.
- 3) School Bicycling Safety: LAPD used to do bicycle safety rodeos. Some elementary PTAs are offering cycling classes. Jim Fenton will look into training programs for schools.
- 4) Stevens Creek Task Force – Timeline to publicize the 2nd community workshop targeted for Dec. 5. Need money from City Council for publicity. Consultant's report will have up to 5 alternatives. There is no public release of the document prior to the workshop, but City staff have been briefed on it. An independent facilitator will be hired.
- 5) Traffic Commission: Joint meeting with City Council was held. 4 recommendations were made to Council. 2007 Federal Safe Routes to School grant application will be rewritten and submitted to California. Proposal will not be changed.
- 6) CIP update. Grant and Fremont rebuild almost done. Do bike detectors work?

Adobe Creek bridge design done, now awaiting Federal funding.
- 7) VTA BPAC Mary Ave. bridge from Sunnyvale to Cupertino. Is short \$6.5M. Cupt & SV will kick in a little more money, but VTA will likely find some way to fund the difference.
