Minutes of Sept 19, 2007 meeting

- 1) New member Jim Fenton introduced
- 2) Approval of minutes of July 18, 2007 meeting
- 3) Bike Rack location: Kathy Small took input on placement of racks as recommended by BPAC and Rec department. Not all racks have been installed yet.
- 4) Stevens Creek Task Force: met with staff from Sunnyvale, Mountain View, and Cupertino and Alta Design. Sunnyvale continues to be uninterested in any involvement beyond connecting spurs to the main trail. Cupertino's plan is for no asphalt, something like decomposed granite or "Nature Pave". It is intended to be a recreation trail connecting to Rancho San Antonio, where the trail is in County jurisdiction.
- 5) Grand opening of renovated Marymeade Park Sep 30. BPAC will have a booth with SCT info.
- 6) Traffic Commission Update: TC proposed 4 sections of streets near schools that could benefit from sidewalks or Class I paths: El Monte nr. Covington, Carmel Terrace nr. Portland, Oak Ave. nr Grant, and W. Portola by Egan Jr. High. Scott presented statistics from bicycle and pedestrian accidents in the city from 2003-2006. This is being rolled up and sent to City Council.
- 7) Pedestrian / Bike CIP – BPAC will review Safe Routes to School design. Embedded crosswalk lights for San Antonio Road are due by end of 2007.
- 8) No VTA update, but Cupertino will redesign Mary Ave. bike bridge to reduce cost overrun. VTA may find additional funds.
