SUBJECT: Installation of sculptures at 160 First Street

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the final location for the installation of three sculptures in front of 160 First Street

BACKGROUND

On April 14, 2015, the Public Arts Commission presented a recommendation to the City Council to approve installation of a series of three sculptures by Pokey Park (Attachment 1) in front of 160 First Street (Safeway). The Council approved the installation of the sculptures, subject to the final placement being approved by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission.

DISCUSSION

The sculptures are proposed to be installed in front of the Safeway store near the State Street end of the building (Attachment 2). The location chosen is away from any egress/ingress to the store. There are no street fixtures on the sidewalk in the chosen locale. The sidewalk is ten feet wide with three foot tree wells along the street. There is no parking along this portion of First Street.

Two of the sculptures have bases that measure 20” by 20” and the third measures 20” by 33”.
