### **BACKGROUND**

One of the primary roles of the Public Arts Commission (PAC) is to promote the installation of public art within the City of Los Altos. At the October 23, 2014 PAC meeting, the PAC discussed a number of potential sculpture installations within the City.

### **DISCUSSION**

On November 25, 2014, the PAC submitted a recommendation, which was approved, to the City Council for the installation of two new sculptures: *Jazzy* at 127 First Street and *Dancing Moon Rollers* at Los Altos Avenue and West Edith Avenue.

On October 23, 2014, the PAC recommended installation of the sculpture *Magic Garden* in Village Park. The proposed location is approximately where the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art installation *I Do Not Know But Am Open to Learning* was located. *Magic Garden* is 13 feet high by 3 feet wide.

On December 11, 2014, the PAC recommended installation of two sculptures, *By the Sea 2* and *Red Lizard Rock* in Redwood Grove. The proposed location is near where the current piece, *By the Sea*, is located.

The installations would be for a two year period.
