## DISCUSSION

At the June 14, 2016 City Council meeting, the Council approved two items related to the Public Arts Commission (PAC).

The first item was a recommendation from the PAC to install four sculptures within the City. Staff is working with the artists regarding installation. The first installation is scheduled for August 1, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. and is for *Stainless Heart, Edition Three* at Main and Third Streets. The other pieces will be installed at a later time.

The second item was the approval of the Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Included in the CIP are funds for the annual arts projects (\$10,000) and funds for an Arts Master Plan (\$50,000). Staff has begun drafting a Request for Proposals for a consultant to work on the Arts Master Plan.

At the July 12, 2016 City Council meeting, the Council approved the donation of two pieces of artwork, *Shlama* and *Conversation Peace*, as recommended by the PAC. Staff is working with the donors on the installation details of these two pieces.

At the June 23, 2016 PAC meeting, the PAC discussed having art activities on the Third Street Green. Staff has checked with the organizers of the Third Street Green and been informed that there is not time nor space for the Public Arts Commission to have programmed art activities. However, the PAC is able to propose ideas for programming at similar, future events.
