

Traffic Commission Minutes
Special Meeting

Present: Chair Crook, Vice Chair Riffle, Commissioners Avra, Ayres, Collins, Davidson, Lopatin

1. Accepted minutes from Commission meeting of October 27, 2004. (Riffle/Collins 7-0)

2. NTMP Subcommittee Recommendations:

- 1) \$3030 fee. OK if (i) credited against future project costs and (ii) refunded if Staff recommended plan is not completed within six months. Motion by Commissioner Ayers, seconded by Vice-Chair Riffle . Passed 6-1 (Crook dissenting)
- 2) Speed Humps should not be listed as inappropriate in Los Altos .Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Chair Crook. Passed 7-0.
- 3) Temporary Devices should be permitted for more than six months in the event that the failure to install permanent devices is not the neighborhood's fault (e.g. the neighborhood has the funds, but the Council has not allocated sufficient funds; the City hasn't completed the finished installation, etc.) Motion by Commissioner Avra, seconded by Commssioner Ayers. Passed 7-0.
- 4) 50/50 City match. Should be 2/3 City. The \$ 3030 fee is the best initial barrier to frivolous requests, and if the reason the Council doesn't approve the 17% increased cost share, the neighborhood could always come up with the balance.. 33%/67% Motion by Commssioner Ayers, seconded by Commssioner Lopatin. Passed 5-2 (Ayers and Crook dissenting)
- 5) Neighborhood approval requirement. Should be simple majority of 30% neighborhood and 67% adjacent owner approval. Motion by Vice Chair Riffle, seconded by Chair Crook. Passed 7-0.

3. Eastwood Drive Traffic Calming: Commssioner Lopatin made a motion, seconded by Vice Chair Riffle, to accept Staff's recommendation to place "No Right Turn between 7-10 Sign" per the NTMP. Passed 6-1 (Davidson dissenting)

4. Pharmacy: Commissioner Davidson, seconded by Commissioner Lopatin made a motion to accept Staff's recommendation regarding the Elephant Paharmacy as long as the bikr racks meet the specifications listed in the Bicycle Transportation Plan. Passed 7-0
