

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS, HELD ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3, 2009 AT 7:00 P.M. AT LOS ALTOS CITY HALL, ONE NORTH SAN ANTONIO ROAD, LOS ALTOS, CALIFORNIA

ROLL CALL

PRESENT: Chair Gallagher, Vice Chair Tollinger, Commissioners Crook, Chan, Davidson, Ayers, and Pasturel

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chair Gallagher led the pledge of allegiance.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Rosita Park Master Plan

City Manager, Doug Schmitz, presented Rosita Park Master Plan to the Traffic Commission and requested input.

Terry Record, landscape architectural consultant, opened the presentation with an overview of the progress to date then gave specific details for the redesign of the park and concluded with general comments.

The Commissioners suggested the following: traffic calming bump outs for Rosita, decrease size of Rosita dead-end to prevent 3-point turn around, one-way in and out for Park parking, safe drop-off areas for school children, higher backstop on baseball field, parking restrictions on La Prenda and an all weather pathway from Arboleda entrance to the tennis courts.

Los Altos residents Jim Fenton and Jeff Wilde addressed comments to the Consultant and the Commission.

2. Revisions to Traffic Calming Toolkit

The Traffic Calming Toolkit recommendations were discussed and the following motions were approved.

Commissioner Crook made a motion to approve Recommendation #1 for making changes to the toolkit, Commissioner Ayers second it, passed unanimously.

Commissioner Davidson made a motion to approve Recommendation #2 to add a traffic calming device fact sheet for “sharrows”, Commissioner Crook second it. Passed 5 – 2

Commissioner Crook made a motion to do additional research on Recommendation #3 for an enhanced form of stop sign delimiters, Commissioner Tollinger second, passed unanimously.
