2. University Avenue NTMP  
Staff and Steve Fitzsimmons gave a presentation on the proposal for putting speed humps on University Avenue for traffic calming.

After much discussion on the recommendation to put speed humps on University Avenue for traffic calming the Commission made the following motion:

Commissioner Bill Crook made a motion to approve the University Avenue NTMP as it is presented to us with the request that it reflect the purpose to have the speed humps more designed like N. Clark. Kurt Ayers second it. Approved 5-0

3. NTMP Revisions  
Commissioners Tollinger and Pasturel are working together on the NTMP revisions. They are currently putting together a survey to get input from residents.

The recommendation from the Traffic Commission for Commissioners Tollinger and Pasturel is to provide information to the Council regarding the NTMP revisions: process, objectives in terms of time and overall what wants to be accomplished.

4. Intersection Pedestrian Safety Prioritization

After some discussion the Traffic Commission decided to continue this discussion to the September meeting, get some data on counts and be better informed to make recommendations. Chair Gallagher summarized what needed to be done to present this to Council on the 22<sup>nd</sup>.
