3. Safe Routes to School Raised Crosswalks  
Jim Gustafson gave a presentation to the Commissioners regarding raised crosswalks and signage. The Commissioners gave feedback to staff with recommendations on raised crosswalks vs. speed humps.
4. Continuation of Complete Streets discussion  
Commissioner Crook made a motion to switch item 5 before item 4 and Commissioner Davidson second. Approved 6-0

The Commissioners recommended that Complete Streets be presented in the Pedestrian Master Plan as part of the presentation with the Council or request another meeting in early spring to present the recommendations for Complete Streets including putting all plans (i.e., Traffic calming, Pedestrian Master Plan, etc.) under one project.

5. Review of Pedestrian Master Plan  
Suzanne Ambiel, BPAC member, gave a presentation to the Commissioners regarding the Pedestrian Master Plan and requested feedback to modify or improve the presentation that will be given to the Council in October.

The Commissioners suggested that more information be presented to the Council which will allow them to understand that a Pedestrian Master Plan needs to be in place in order for the city to receive part of a grant. They also suggested that more funds be allotted to this project.

6. Continuation of NTMP revisions discussion  
Commissioner Crook made a motion to continue next month, Commissioner Chiang second.  
Approved 6-0
