

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NON-COMPETITIVE  
FUNDS FROM SANTA CLARA COUNTY UNDER THE FEDERAL HOUSING  
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008/2009**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Los Altos has previously entered into a Joint Powers Agreement with Santa Clara County to form an Urban County under the Housing and Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held duly noticed public hearings on February 12, 2008 and March 11, 2008 on the allocation of funds under the Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the following proposals represent the community development needs in Los Altos.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that staff is hereby authorized to submit proposals for the expenditures of CDBG funds in the amount of \$133,214 as described below:

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the final 2008/2009 CDBG funding allocations are provisioned as follows:

1. That the City's CDBG program is fully funded by the Federal government; and
2. That any unspent Capital Improvement Project funding shall be returned to the City.

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT** staff is authorized to submit the proposed amendments to the City's prior year allocations as described below:


1. Transfer \$8,305.22 from LA-07-51 Housing Rehab Loans to LA-09-41 ADA Pedestrian Push Buttons at Signalized Intersections project.
2. Transfer \$7,253.57 from LA-08-41 Springer/Foothill ADA Access project to LA-09-41 ADA Pedestrian Push Buttons at Signalized Intersections project.
3. Transfer \$6,917 from LA-06-41 Garden House Project funds to LA-09-41 ADA Pedestrian Push Buttons at Signalized Intersection project.

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the City will enter into a Two-Year Funding Cycle for allocating CDBG public service grants starting fiscal year FY 2009/10 through FY 2010/11. This would only be for public service funds, not the capital or administrative funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute standard CDBG contracts between the City and the non-profit agencies for FY 2008/2009.
