



Emergency Preparedness

- Prevention/Mitigation
 - Knowing the condition of the assets
 - Taking steps to minimize damages
- Preparedness
- Response
- Recovery



We Are Storm Ready

Prevention/Mitigation

- Preparing sandbag stations
- Cleaning Storm drains
- Inspecting/cleaning ditches/hot spots
- Inspecting/trimming trees
- Removing dead trees
- Inspecting/waterproofing traffic signal equipment



We Are Storm Ready

Preparedness

- Preparing and maintaining necessary equipment
- Trainings
- Conducting emergency drills
- Developing emergency call out list
- Maintaining hot spot list
- Coordination with partner agencies/companies



What You Can Do to Prepare?



- Getting sandbags if necessary
- Trimming/maintaining trees
- Collecting/properly disposing of heavy leaves
- Removing leaves and debris from storm drain inlets using a rake or shovel
- Preparing an emergency kit


