SUBJECT: BPAC Work Plan

RECOMMENDATION:

Review and provide comments to a draft of the 2015/16 BPAC Work Plan

BACKGROUND

At the Council Retreat in January 2015, the City Council elected to provide commissions more flexibility in addressing topics of their concern and within their charter. The City Council determined that commission work plans will be reviewed at the joint Council-Commission meeting in March/April, but will no longer need to be approved.

DISCUSSION

The City Council's goal is to provide leeway to the commissions to address issues that may come up outside of their goals in the work plan. The City Council understands that commission flexibility can be of greater service to the residents of Los Altos.

In consultation with the BPAC Chair, a draft work plan was developed for review. The plan carries over some typical BPAC work, but also includes topics of interest that have come up in the past year. Again, issues and items outside of the work plan can be addressed given at least three commission members support it's discussion.

Staff requests the commission provide comments to the draft work plan. A final draft will be presented to the BPAC at the regular meeting in March.
