

## Chapter 8.32 - BICYCLES

### Sections:

#### 8.32.010 - Registration.

It shall be unlawful for any person to use, ride, or propel a bicycle or any similar vehicle upon which a person may ride (excluding small tricycles) which is not such as to require registration under the provisions of the Vehicle Code of the state without having registered such bicycle or vehicle with the city and paying the license fee required by Section 8.32.030 of this chapter.

#### 8.32.020 - Registration procedure.

Any resident owner of any vehicle designated in Section 8.32.010 of this chapter shall present such vehicle to the appropriate department of the city before such vehicle is used, ridden, or propelled upon any street or public place in the city. The city shall cause a record to be made of the name and address of the owner of such vehicle and the manufacturer's number assigned to the vehicle, with a brief description of the vehicle.

#### 8.32.030 - License fees.

There shall be paid by the owner of such vehicle at the time of such registration a license fee of two dollars (\$2.00).

#### 8.32.040 - Bicycle license indicia.

Upon registration as provided in Section 8.32.020 of this chapter and the payment of the fee required by Section 8.32.030 of this chapter, there shall be provided a bicycle license indicia which shall be affixed immediately to the frame of the bicycle where it can be easily seen. Bicycle licenses shall be renewed uniformly throughout the state at periods, not to exceed five years, to be designated by the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles of the state. The renewal of a bicycle license shall be indicated by a supplementary adhesive device affixed on or near the indicia.

#### 8.32.050 - Transfers of ownership.

Upon the sale or other transfer of a registered bicycle, the new owner shall within ten (10) days, register that fact with the appropriate department of the city and shall obtain a certificate thereof. A fee of two dollars (\$2.00) shall be charged.

8.32.060 - Changes of address.

Whenever the owner of a bicycle licensed pursuant to the provisions of this chapter changes his address, he shall, within ten (10) days, notify the appropriate licensing agency of the old and new address.

8.32.070 - Violations—Penalties.

Any violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to a fine not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00).
