SUBJECT: Project Inventory Database

RECOMMENDATION:

Review and discuss the Project Inventory Database (PID)

BACKGROUND

The original database started with over 250 projects that were submitted by the BPAC from sources ranging from existing studies, plans, personal observation, and requests from the public. A sub-committee was formed to refine the project's key identifiers and to consolidate like information. The project inventory database currently has 252 identified projects, which includes projects from the Pedestrian Master Plan. The projects are not ranked or prioritized, merely is an evolving database.

DISCUSSION

The last database update was in September/October 2015. No additions have been made since then. Almost all the projects come from various city master plans or studies. The PID will be presented at the meeting for the commissions review.
