Los Altos Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee June 20, 2007 Minutes

Present: Staff Lind, Members Hlavka, Rhody, Hagenmeier, Chan, Pastorelli. Absent: Crook

Discussion items:

- 1) Minutes of 5/16/07 meeting approved with additions regarding public comments.
- 2) Discussion of bicyclists crossing Covington at Golden Way in an unsafe manner using the existing N-S crosswalk on the east side of the intersection. Carl observed many southbound riders (most heading in direction of Blach Jr. High) cross Golden Way before reaching Covington, ride against traffic to reach the crosswalk. They then cross Covington using the crosswalk and proceed east on Covington. Motion: Recommendation to add a north-south crosswalk across Covington on west side of intersection. Passes 5-0.
- 3) Planning Department asked for review of proposed 2 story office bldg at 45 Main St/San Antonio. Recommend sidewalk around site connect to existing sidewalk and be ADA compliant. VTA Bike guidelines are for 1 class 1 (Secure indoor/locker) bike parking space.
- 4) Planning Department asked for review of proposed redevelopment at 100 First St., consisting of a 2-story office/condo building and separate US Post Office retail site. City is studying reconfiguring street/sidewalk already. VTA bike parking guidelines Condo: 4 class 1 (indoor/garage/locker) and 4 class 2 racks. Office: 3 Class 1 and 1 Class 2 (rack). Post Office: 1 Class 1 and two class 2 racks in front for customers.
- 5) Replacement for empty BPAC seat: 1 applicant has sent an application but has not attended a meeting. Another interested party has attended a meeting but not submitted an application. Carl to follow up with applicant.
- 6) Stevens Creek Task Force: Task Force will meet with city staff and Alta Design to go over input from the May 30 public meeting. Discussed if/how project should change away from Stevens Creek moniker.
- 7) Bike Detectors: Scott will send spreadsheet to Randy to post on BPAC website.
- 8) Bike to Work Day: 358 bikes passed or stopped at the 2 Los Altos stations.
- 9) CIP Projects: Bike Racks site photos were reviewed by Bill Crook, Chris Hlavka, and PARC commissioner and Rec staff. Comments will be sent to Public Works staff.
- 10) VTA: Nothing noteworthy
- 11) Traffic Commission update: discussed accident statistics.
