Purpose

Accept the completion of the W. Edith Avenue and University Avenue Crosswalk Improvement, Project TS-01034

Background

On June 22, 2017, the City Council awarded the W. Edith Avenue and University Avenue Crosswalk Improvement, Project TS-01034 to Wattis Construction for contract amount of \$234,324.00.

The approved work for this contract consists of three (3) ADA ramps, a bulb-out, a marked crosswalk, and an in-road warning light system with static signs.

Discussion/Analysis

Project TS-01034 was completed in accordance with the contract plans and specifications, and complies with the Standard Specifications of the City of Los Altos. The final cost of the construction contract with Wattis Construction was \$274,261.17. This includes three (4) change orders:

- Change Order No. 1 includes a no cost change order to amend the Special Provisions of the contract with updated language.
- Change Order No. 2 includes a \$18,670 to repair damaged concrete curb & gutter and was funded by the Annual Concrete Repair, Project TS-01005.
- Change Order No. 3 includes a \$20,091.69 change to install Light Emitting Diode (LED)
 Enhanced signs to increase visibility of pedestrians using the facility, which was not included
 in the original contract.
- Change Order No. 4 includes a \$1,175.48 change to paint the four (4) poles, TNEMEC black which was not specified on the project plans.

All work was completed and is acceptable. Recording of the Notice of Completion begins the 35-day lien-filing period for subcontractors and suppliers. At the end of the 35-day period, the City releases the 5% retention amount to the contractor if no liens are filed. Attachment 1 is the proposed resolution of acceptance.

Options

1) Adopt Resolution No. 2018-05

Advantages: City can close Project TS-01034 for FY 2017/18

Disadvantages: None identified

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Improvement TS-01034 acceptance

2) Do not adopt Resolution No. 2018-05

Advantages: None identified

Disadvantages: This is not recommended since the project has been completed in accordance

with the contract plans and specifications and the remaining retention will not

be able to be release as required by law.

Recommendation
