CONSENT CALENDAR

Action: Upon a motion by Vice Mayor Lee Eng, seconded by Councilmember Bruins, the Council unanimously approved the Consent Calendar, as follows:

- 1. Council Minutes: Approved the minutes of the March 13, 2018 study session.
- 2. <u>Construction Contract Award: Police Department Building Roof Replacement, Project CF-01003</u>: Awarded the Base Bid for the Police Department Building Roof Replacement, Project CF-01003 in the amount of \$191,900 to Stronger Building Services and authorized the City Manager to execute a contract on behalf of the City.
- 3. <u>Endorsement of Measure E: Mountain View Los Altos High School District</u>: Endorsed Measure E: Mountain View Los Altos High School District.

Action: Upon a motion by Councilmember Bruins, seconded by Councilmember Pepper, the Council unanimously directed staff to negotiate an exclusive negotiating agreement that returns to the City Council for approval and is generally based on the following terms: 1) a 10-year minimum to 20-year maximum lease with flexibility between the two to mitigate risk to the City; 2) consideration of alternative construction methodologies; 3) design costs imposed upon Children's Corner shall be based on actual costs; 4) return to Council with firm cost estimates so negotiating teams can plan for the division of risk between the City and Children's Corner; 5) the City's maximum debt would be \$2 million; and 6) the flexibility to return to Council with a lease agreement if all details start to align into such a document.

5. <u>Tentative Council Calendar</u>: Review the Tentative Council Calendar and provide direction of placement of items on the Calendar

Action: Councilmembers discussed the Tentative Council Calendar and came to the following general consensus: schedule the May 8, 2018 item on Cannabis Ordinance direction as part of the regular meeting, schedule the evaluation of Floor Area Ratio as an educational item, provide an update on the Community Center based on individual Council discussions with the architects, add the performance evaluations for the City Manager and City Attorney, add a presentation regarding the North County Library Authority Library Redevelopment Task Force, add the Shoulder Paving Policy to the To be scheduled category and include those items identified in the Council Priorities regarding housing which are not currently included.
