We are emailing you because of our deep concerns over Ordinance No. 2020-474. Due to the on-going global pandemic, our business has seen a dramatic decrease in revenue and customers. We have struggled to pay rent, keep our great staff members employed, and to pay all other necessary costs to stay afloat. With Ordinance No. 2020-474 in place, our business will suffer more and be forced to shut down permanently.

Although we see the environmental impact of this ordinance, there is no alternative solution for boba shops to replace plastic use in shops. If there were, it would still be additional costs our store simply could not take on. We hope that you will reconsider this ordinance during these troubling times for local Los Altos business owners.
