Mayor Pepper moved that the City have a tracking data base that would track both formal and informal complaints. An independent intake portal will be retained by the City to do intake for informal and formal complaints about Los Altos Police Officers. The independent intake portal will share all informal and formal complaints received with the Police Department within a reasonable amount of time and will also receive informal and formal complaints that are initiated at the Police Department. This independent intake portal will track all informal and formal complaints according to the list recommended by the Task Force presented in the staff report. All formal complaints (investigation and resolution) shall not exceed one-year from the submission date or within the time frame set forth by current law. The independent intake portal will receive copies of all reports from the Police Department of the results of their investigation, and produce an annual report of informal and formal complaints to the City Council and the information deemed appropriate for public disclosure be made available online including demographic information. The Police Department will collect additional data about the complainants and the nature of their complaints. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Fligor the motion passed 5-0 with the following roll call vote:

"The Complaint Procedure":

- i. "An investigator will be assigned to investigate the complaint."
- ii. "If the investigation proves that the employee violated any laws or policy of the Los Altos Police Department, he/she may (will?) be subject to the Department's discipline process*. In addition, investigations that disclose potential criminal activity may (will?) be referred to the District Attorney for criminal prosecution." (*explanation of why behavior would not be subject to discipline)

- d. Display clearly on the city website the complaint process with a flow chart of all of the steps involved in different circumstances
- e. At every traffic stop and pedestrian stop, officers are strongly encouraged to give information about how to file a complaint/commendation on a business card and/or brochure.

Subject: Resolution No. 2020-40: Declaration of election results and canvass of returns

Purpose

To adopt a Resolution certifying the results of the November 3, 2020 General Municipal Election.

Background

The California State Elections Code Section 15400 *et seq.* requires the City to declare elected the person (or persons) having the highest number of votes for office as well as the results of all City ballot measures if any. An election was held on November 3, 2020 to fill three seats on the City Council.

Discussion/Analysis

The Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters completed the canvass of returns and has counted the ballots cast.

Council Election

A total of 45,832 votes were cast (voters were allowed to cast up to 3 votes). The following details the results of the election:

The total number of voters voting in the election was 20,020 or 90.58% of 22,101 registered voters.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
RECITING THAT A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION WAS HELD IN THE
CITY OF LOS ALTOS ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020, CONFIRMING
THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS AND DECLARING THE RESULT**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Los Altos, California on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, as required by law, for the purpose of filling three seats on the City Council; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law, voting centers were properly established, election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and their return made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council, which are attached as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Los Altos hereby declares as follows:

1. That the canvass is confirmed, and that the following are the results of the canvass of the election:
 - A. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except vote by mail voter ballots and provisional ballots was 844 as set forth in the Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Election attached as Exhibit A
 - B. That the whole number of vote by mail voter ballots cast in the City was 19,176 making a total of 20,020 ballots cast in the City, as set forth in the Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Election attached as Exhibit A
 - C. That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

- D. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective office for which the persons were candidates are attached as Exhibit A

The City Council does declare and determine that the following results are true and correct, and that the following persons were elected to their respective offices and that the following measures were either passed or failed:

- a. That Sally Meadows, Lynette Lee Eng and Jonathan D. Weinberg were the candidates for City Council who received the highest number of votes and have therefore been elected to full terms of four years each
2. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the results of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of voters/ballots cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and (5) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure
3. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected
4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions

Subject: Council reorganization

Purpose

To select a Mayor and Vice Mayor for 2020/21.

Background

Section 2.2 of the Council Norms and Procedures details the process for the Election of Mayor (for complete text of the section, see the [Council Norms and Procedures](#)):

“Election of Mayor. Only Council members elected by the voters may serve as Mayor...the term of office shall be one year. The Council member must have served at least 23 months to be eligible for Mayor. A majority vote of the Council is necessary to designate the Mayor. If there is at least one elected Council member with a minimum of 23 months of service who has not served as Mayor, he or she shall be designated Mayor before those who have already served as Mayor.”

Section 2.3 outlines the process for the Election of Vice Mayor (for complete text of the section, see the [Council Norms and Procedures](#)):

“Election of Vice Mayor. Only Council members elected by the voters may serve as Vice Mayor...the selection process for determining who shall serve as Vice Mayor will follow that of Mayor, except the Councilmember must have served at least 11 months to be eligible to serve as Vice Mayor.”

Discussion/Analysis

The following is a list of Council members in order of seniority and service record:

- Council Member Lee Eng (re-elected in 2020 with the second highest number of votes originally elected in 2016 with the third highest number of votes, previously served as Vice Mayor in 2017/18 and Mayor 2018/19)
- Council Member Fligor elected in 2018 with the highest number of votes, served as Vice Mayor 2019/20)
- Council Member Enander (elected in 2018 with the second highest number of votes, no previous service as Vice Mayor or Mayor)
- Council Member Sally Meadows elected in 2020 with the highest number of votes
- Council Member Jonathan Weinberg elected in 2020 with the third highest number of votes

Any Councilmember may offer a nomination for the position of Mayor, with no second required. If at least three affirmative votes are cast, the nominated member becomes the Mayor.



Subject: Council reorganization

Following the selection of Mayor, any Councilmember may offer a nomination for Vice Mayor. A second is not required. If at least three affirmative votes are cast, the nominated member becomes the Vice Mayor.

Options

- 1) Submit nominations for Mayor and Vice Mayor for 2020/21

Advantages: Allows for the selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor for 2020/21

Disadvantages: None identified

- 2) Alter the process and/or timing for selecting Mayor and Vice Mayor for 2020/21

Advantages: None identified

Disadvantages: This may delay the selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor

Recommendation

The staff recommends Option 1.
