### ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION/ACTION

1. <u>General Guidelines for Citizens' Task Force:</u> Review and discuss scope, objective and timeline of Task Force

Judge LaDoris Cordell introduced herself as the Task Force facilitator and gave a brief background about herself and what the goals of this Task Force will be. The Task Force will meet weekly until recommendations are reached.

2. <u>Introduction to principles of the Brown Act:</u> Staff will present a brief introduction on the guidelines of the Brown Act

Deputy City Manager Jon Maginot presented a brief introduction to the Brown Act.

3. <u>Police Officer Feedback Process:</u> Review the current citizens' feedback process and develop recommendations for City Council

4. <u>School Resource Officer (SRO) Program:</u> Review the role of SROs at Los Altos High School and develop recommendations for City Council

Police Captain Katie Krauss introduced herself and gave a history of the SRO position, what the program looks like, and what specialized trainings School Resource Officers receive.

Task Force members asked clarifying questions and requested data for the following meeting. Requested data consisted of mental health calls at the Los Altos High School, quantity of calls that were responded to by the SRO compared to calls where non-SROs responded, total time SRO spends on campus, calls where Mountain View Police Department responded to, and all SRO citations issued at the High School from the 2017-18 school year to March 2020.

5. <u>Strategies and tools to obtain the necessary information/data</u>: Discuss strategies and tools needed to obtain necessary information/data to develop recommendations for City Council

The Task Force created a subcommittee to draft, develop and present student survey questions intended for the Los Altos High School student body. Task Force members Janet Corrigan, Curtis Cole, and Renee Rashid were assigned to this subcommittee.

The Task Force requested Staff coordinate with the School District to secure possible interviews with an Administrator(s) and faculty to discuss the SRO program.
