


City of Los Altos Status of Response to COVID-19 Emergency

 January 25: State lifts Bay Area Regional Stay Home order – County restrictions still in place



City of Los Altos Emergency Response Status

- •All Facilities remain closed to the public
- •Playgrounds and restrooms are open, bu gamerings are prohibited
- •Construction projects and land ap tenance are allowed
- •Police and Maintenance savings continue to operate as normal
- •Building inspections on the with increased vigilance toward protecting staff and commun
- •Staff that do not need to be in the office do not come in
- •Staff continues monitor what services can continue to be safely provided to the public

Individuals' Response Status

- 1. Practice Social Distancing
- 2. Wear a mask
- 3. Avoid gatherings whose er possible
- 4. Follow CDC, State and Jounty guidelines
- 5. When it's your, get vaccinated
- 6. Continut practicing 1-4 even after being vaccinated

- County currently in process of vaccinating Phase 1A and partial Phase 1B
 - Includes health care workers and residents and employees of skilled nursing facilities
 - All individuals 65+ (regardless of health insurance)
