City Council Meeting October 26th - Item 5 Public Comments

Dear City Council and staff:

PARC and council have both failed dog owners once again. Tuesday, is another chance to undo the damage and do what is fair and needed for better use of our open park shared spaces.

What owners want and deserve is to have off-leash hours at most if not all neighborhood parks in order to make friends and have healthy pets. Is asking for a few hours a day to share open space too much?

I sent a much shorter version of this letter to the Town Crier about "The Failure of PARC" but not sure if it will get published because the power structure that runs Los Altos also controls this newspaper.

I hope you carefully review what I have to say and take action to fix the mess now on your watch. Here are the sad facts:

1. After more than 13 years, parks and recreation commissioners [PARC] mainly discovered that dogs bark and a few will dig holes and voted 4-2 to start over. Can you imagine that?
2. A group of South Los Altos dog owners were very active in support of PARC and willing to accept anything – so we wound up with the Hillview Little League site because it was better than nothing but did nothing for us. Equally important, past actions over the years by staff and other councils led PARC to making this poor choice.
3. While PARC dithered for yet another year the South Los Altos dog owners lost interest either because the site is too far away, dogs passed, or owners moved. Meanwhile, Cupertino finished their pilot program and made this location an off-leash hour dog park! I expect Cupertino will add more in the future like Mountain View already has.
4. PARC ignored a new group of over 300 North Los Altos dog owners that wanted to work with the Little League and nearby Hillview venues to solve the identified problems [after choosing the worst place for a pilot program and too far away from most residents to use].
5. PARC ignored repeated public requests to add perimeter fences at most of our parks for the safety of kids and dogs. Commissioners also ignored pleas for fencing around playgrounds to keep dogs away from kids or passing waste like other towns do.
6. PARC ignored their most effective commissioner when he asked for pilot program enforcement, 100% oversight, and immediate response if issues occurred.
7. PARC learned that PARC neighbors will strongly oppose off-leash hours at "their park" no matter where the location may be. This is not unique to Los Altos. For example, Los Gatos has but one park with tennis courts. When they easily added colored lines to create 4 pickle ball courts at

one tennis court residents flocked to this park to play pickle ball. The neighbors complained about more parked cars so they did not add more pickle ball courts despite the need to do so.

8. Pilot programs are useful to find out what works and what does not. But, we now have all the facts and there is no need for another pilot program or more data because we should now know how to implement off-leash hours in most of our parks. We are not going to learn anything more by collecting more data or starting another pilot program.
9. The majority on this council “essentially fired a highly effective PARC commissioner this year whom was about to become the 2021 chair person. Their votes were based slander told by one of them that afterward the accuser admitted was a lie. But, now their hand-picked replacement cast the deciding vote to end the pilot program and start over. How fair is that!

So here is the ongoing situation you can decide to change or not:

- Dog owners will continue to illegally let pet’s off-leash mainly for exercise in the morning but are more afraid to do it when they socialize with “dog friends” during the 4-6 pm window. In the afternoon some drive to other towns like me to socialize instead. “Ain’t that a shame”?
- Residents will continue to call police when dogs are off-leash [even when no other people are present] but no amount of enforcement will ever stop off-leash activity. Not to mention whether or not fines from \$80-\$500 make sense. For the worst example, one past Grant Park homeowner called the police about 90 times in one year. And, last year someone called the police with a false police report that my dog was off-leash when she was not because I spoke in favor of off-leash hours at a PARC meeting. So, when residents can harass neighbors with needless complaints instead of being good neighbors the result is not good for our community.
- The division between dog owners and non-dog owners will continue. My calculation shows 55% favor keeping dogs on leash. This fact is no different than any other nearby community.
- The major impediment is that non-dog owners do not want to share one minute of time or any space with dogs off-leash or cannot seem to understand that they can choose to use or not use the park during these few daily hours if concerned or afraid of dogs. That is why Mountain View chose to just do it instead of dithering for over 13 years like Los Altos.

Many dog owners I know are fed up and want council to immediately implement off-leash hours at most parks so we can walk to them like other progressive towns have done. While non-dog owners will continue to intimidate council to do nothing – dog owners deserve better.

Subject: PUBLIC COMMENT – AGENDA ITEM #5 – 10/26/2021 Receive report and staff recommendation to City Council discontinue the off-leash program at the Hillview Baseball Field and direct staff and the Parks and Recreation Commission (PARC) to explore additional fenced-in options for dogs in Los Altos. (D. Legge)

Disclosure: I am a member of PARC; however, I submit this public comment as a private resident of Los Altos.

Dear Councilmembers, City Manager, et al.,

I endorse the PARC Subcommittee's report and encourage the Council to accept their recommendations wholly: 1) to cease the use of Hillview baseball field as an off-leash area and 2) to continue its work to identify and test additional fenced in options for dogs in Los Altos.

I refer the Council to my public comment letter I sent to you on 9/20/2021, where I discuss my concerns about Hillview Baseball as an off-leash area. My concerns include increased risk and liability, the inequities it poses to certain segments of our community, its negative impact on use of and access to the civic center, and its co-location with a sports field.

As I have thought about this matter further and read much on the topic, I make these additional findings:

- 1) **Dog Park Attributes:** Dog Parks should have these attributes:
 - a. They are plentiful and not large (smaller than Hillview).
 - b. They are entirely fenced in and gated; they have vestibule-type gates if permanent
 - c. They are outfitted with waste bags, signage, and green cloth screening on any side near parking, paths, or play areas.
 - d. Owners are required to be with their dogs in the play area at all times unless the City has made provisions for custodians to take care of dogs.
 - e. No food or drink, other than dog treats or water for dogs are allowed in the dog park.
 - f. No unaccompanied children are allowed in the enclosed area.

- g. No bicycles, skateboards, skates, wagons, strollers, or other human toys are allowed.
- h. They are surfaced with natural or artificial turf, decomposed granite, Turface fines, asphalt, or other hard surface (tennis courts, which can be washed, make great dog parks!).
- i. They are not sports fields.

2) **I envision a Los Altos that is populated with many Mobile and Pop-Up Dog Parks:**

Many communities across the country have established the use of multiple small-scale (between 400 and 5,000 sq feet) mobile dog parks as a means to achieve the following goals:

- a. To test many sites for suitability as permanent dog park sites. Lots of data can be gathered quickly with little investment.
- b. As the main attribute of a community's plan to host dog parks to give more neighborhoods the opportunity to benefit from being within walking- or short-car-ride-distance to a dog park on a rotating schedule. Health benefit to the human, the dog, and the environment are the result.
- c. As part of a hybrid model that deploys both permanent and mobile dog parks on an ongoing basis.
- d. To generally achieve costs savings in materials, installation, and maintenance.
- e. As enablers to a variety of value-added programs for the community: training and socialization, agility and retrieving events, community dog shows, therapeutic exercises for humans conducted by professionals to reduce dog fear, expose non-dog-owning people to dogs, human mental health therapies, and seniors-focus events
- f. As a pop-up service to accompany/augment other city activities or events, such as Farmers Markets and Art Festivals. Dog-sitting services can be provided as a service to community members.
- g. To engage community in becoming more familiar with different parts of their city.
- h. To decrease unlawful activity elsewhere (unlawful activity did not decrease in the pilot because there was just one park).
- i. Through programs offered, to educate dog owners about best practices in dog training and socialization. (Dogs need to be good citizens, too!)

4) **Other Considerations:**

a. Dog ownership has always been high in the City, but it is higher than ever before.

b. Having many dog parks encourages owners to **walk** their dogs to the park. In addition to the health benefits mentioned above, professional dog behaviorists agree that walking one's dog is the single most important component of establishing leadership over one's dog with the added benefit of exercising and training them.

c. People with dogs needing substantial large-scale activity should be able to find other dog parks in neighboring communities that meet their needs.

Dear City Council Members,

I have spoken to each of you previously regarding the need for an off leash dog park in Los Altos. Thank you again for your time! At this juncture, it is actually surprising to me that the topic is still at issue. It is true that there are problems with the Hillview dog park as it is currently designed, but these problems, in my view, do not lead to a conclusion that there should not be an off-leash dog park in our city. Rather, they simply say that we need to solve the problems as best that we can in order to provide a dog park for the significant population within Los Altos that would like one.

We have talked before how Hillview has been a place for dogs to exercise and learn to socialize with other dogs and with people. As significant, it has been a huge community builder for the people that come to Hillview. I have to ask, and emphasize - Isn't this what we want for Los Altos? Do we now want to break apart such a warm and welcoming community? Furthermore, given the significant population within our city that owns a dog, it isn't it only fair that the city address the need by providing a sanctioned off leash dog park?

I understand the concerns with the existing Hillview set up and I believe many in our community have proposed solutions; most obviously, to fence in the area. I would add that increasing the sanctioned hours would perhaps lesson the number of dogs at any one period.

I understand that as compared to other cities, Los Altos has less park space which makes it difficult to easily create a dog park. This however, does not negate the fact that one is needed and should be prioritized for the large population it serves.

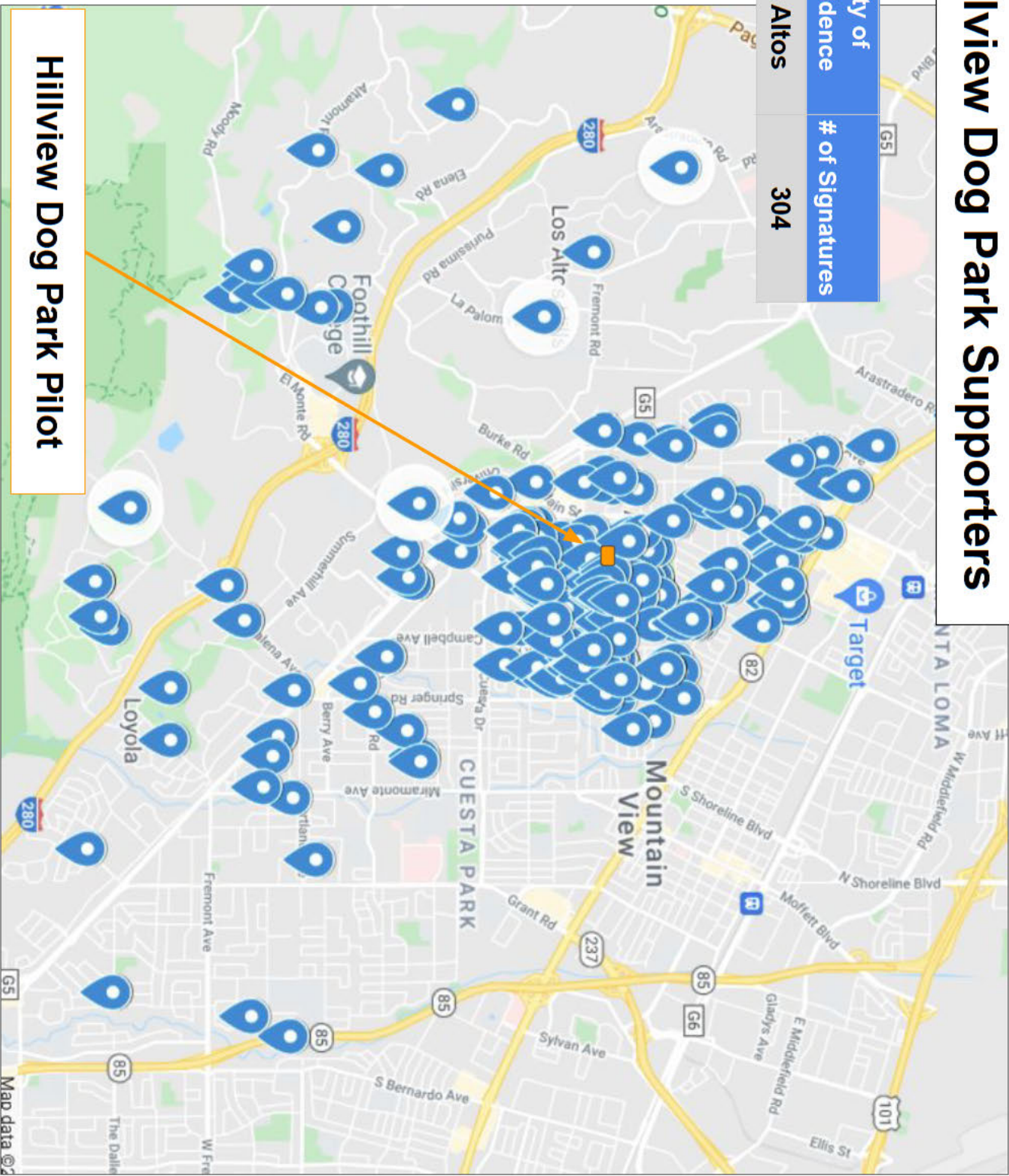

Hello Los Altos City Council Members,

The baseball field at Hillview Park is an important field for Los Altos & Los Altos Hills Little League. We have used it extensively for decades. We didn't use it for the past two seasons due to the construction of the Community Center and the COVID-19 pandemic, but we expect to need the field space as Little League gets back to full swing (pun not intended) post-pandemic. Our organization is not going to make a statement about dog parks in general, but we do want to communicate our view about a joint baseball and dog park field. We don't think that a joint baseball and dog park field can be maintained to the safety and quality standard we require for our young players. There would be too many mini holes and divots in the grass outfield that could lead to sprained ankles and bad hops where the baseball redirects into a kid's body or face. Also, even though dog owners are responsible about picking up after their dogs, we don't want our players fielding balls that have rolled through grass that has had dog poop on it. If there is a shared use field, our organization might opt out of Hillview for baseball, which would challenge us to find enough field space for practices and games.

Again, this is not a statement about dog parks in general; just about the coexistence of a dog park and youth baseball on the same field. We wish you the best as you consider options, and we thank you for the continued partnership and support.

We are all thankful to the city for running the pilot, we are very grateful.

It should be natural for a wealthy town like this to include all groups into their city plans. Many Los Altos households have dogs and I have heard the percentage was 35% when I was out meeting residents to gather petition signatures, it appeared that well over 50% of the houses we visited had a dog and a number had been dog owners in the past.

Dogs bring people together with the Hillview Field Dog Park affording residents the opportunity to actually meet in small groups as their dogs play together. These meetings serve to strengthen neighborhood bonds. Residents who live in the area tell me that they have actually met their neighbors and that their neighborhood has become much closer with a more congenial spirit.
