**I recommend you request moving TS-01051 from FY 22/23 to FY 21/22, so that staff can complete design and construction in FY 21/22.**

Daily 60 to 80 pedestrians plus many dogs walk Milverton, who half walk to downtown, the other half walk to Redwood Grove and Shoup Park. The half going to downtown use “ all stop” signs at Milverton for safe crossing of University. Other half going to Redwood Grove / Shoup park are still walking on University eastbound travel lane since they do not feel safe crossing University at Manresa [enter Redwood Grove via south gate], Shoup Park and Redwood Grove roads. Pedestrian’s visibility crossing in this zone is restricted by parked cars on University. Lincoln crossing lights are too far out of the way.

**Adding University / Milverton “all stop” only solved half of pedestrian safety problem.**

The 60 to 80 residents who almost daily walk Milverton come from Dover Court, O’Keefe, Matts Court, Normandy Lane, Creekside Oaks PUD, Woodstock, and Milverton. Ones without children and dogs go to downtown, the others to Redwood Grove [dogs love going there] and Shoup Park.
