**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR
(TFCA) FUNDS FOR TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS ON EL MONTE
AVENUE BETWEEN ALMOND AVENUE AND RINCONADA COURT**

WHEREAS, traffic calming measures on El Monte Avenue between Almond Avenue and Rinconada Court will reduce speeds near Almond School and potentially encourage children to walk to Almond school, thereby reducing vehicle trips and air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) has made funding available to local agencies for projects which reduce air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the BAAQMD will make the final selection of projects from a combined list of recommended projects from nine bay area counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Los Altos:




