Of the Mayor

WHEREAS, observation of Hispanic Heritage Week started in 1968 under President Lyndon B. Johnson and was later extended to a 30-day celebration by President Ronald Reagan; and

WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Month allows us to honor and celebrate the key leadership roles and accomplishments of Hispanics and Latinos in our community in different professions and sectors, and at all levels of government.
