WHEREAS, this year, the Chinese New Year fell on Saturday, February 10, 2024, and ended with the Lantern Festival on Saturday, February 24, 2024, and thus began the Year of the Dragon, the fifth of the twelve-year cycle of animals which appear in the Chinese Zodiac; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has a rich history and diverse population, and Chinese-Americans of our country continue to have a great impact on the nation's growth and success, serving as professional and community leaders and service providers in all aspects of our nation's way of life including as public servants, philanthropists, artists, entrepreneurs, educators, scientists and more, and they have bravely defended America, serving in each branch of the United States Armed Forces with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Los Altos is comprised of a diverse population of residents, business owners, and students of Asian and Pacific Islander descent; and
