

City of Los Altos Community & Emergency Preparedness Grants Awardees

In the January 2020 Grants Process, we received 14 applications from neighborhood groups, requesting a total of 17 thousand dollars. The applications came from across the City and included a wide range of creative ideas for projects to strengthen community ties and improve neighborhood emergency preparedness. Half of the groups were new applicants to the Grants program, and 2 of the applications were newly registered Block Action Teams.
