Four Year Search for New Site

- Consulted with city organizations, nonprofits, developers
- Top 5 sites evaluated jointly by Friends & City: Rosita, Woodland, MSC, LAYC, Civic Center
- Key driver of locations
 - Transportation of books
 - Ability to host 25+ volunteers at one time
- All non-Civic Center sites presented challenges





Outcome

- 2019: Temporary measures
 - Portable sited near soccer field; sheds near Police Dept.
 - Temporary lease signed by Friends and City
- 2020: City Council authorized City Manager to complete new agreement
- 2021: Friends and City staff drafted license with mutually agreeable terms



Friends' Request

Approve draft of Temporary License Agreement to allow continued use of City land until space is available in renovated Main Library.





License Agreement Terms

- No cost use of City land for Friends' operations & storage
- 10-year initial term, renewed annually thereafter
- Land is licensed "as is," but Friends may install utilities
- Friends to comply with City building requirements

Why 10-year Initial Term?

- Organizational stability
- Financial optimization
 - Maximize funding support for library
 - Minimize capital expense
 - Minimize risk of investment loss
- Provides path to consolidated operations





Benefits of Consolidated Operations

- Allows Friends to return library space to patrons
- Reduces book movement across parking lot
- Volunteers able to work together again






40 Year Friends/City Partnership

- City provided land for Friends operations and sales
- Friends donated nearly \$4 million back to community
 - Bestseller book & media collections, library programs
 - Tables, chairs, technology for Library and City
- □ Friends provide volunteer opportunities for adults & teens
- Community is able to recycle 250K books each year
