SUMMARY OF COUNCIL ACTIONS  
7:00 P.M. – REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**Items for Consideration**

1. The City Council approved the Regular Meeting Minutes for City Council Meetings of June 13, 2023.
2. The City Council accepted the Treasurer's Report for the Month Ended March 31, 2023.
3. The City Council adopted an Ordinance and Resolution for Sanitary Sewer Rates, and found that the approval of the ordinance is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15273 and none of the circumstances in Section 15300.2 applies.
4. The City Council adopted a Resolution accepting completion of the CIPP Corrosion Rehabilitation, Project WW-01005; and authorize the Environmental Services and Utilities Department Director to record a Notice of Completion as required by law.
5. The City Council authorized the City Manager to execute Professional Services Agreement for a Full Cost Allocation Plan, Development Fee Study, and Development Impact Fee Study to Matrix Consulting Group as the most qualified responsive consultant for project total not-to-exceed \$198,885 and approved the City Manager the authority up to 10% contingency if needed, in the amount not-to-exceed \$19,888.50.
6. The City Council approved and adopted a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement with R3 Consulting Group, Inc. for On-Call Solid Waste Support Services for FY 2023/2024.
7. The City Council adopted a Resolution identifying street maintenance projects to be funded by Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) Road Repair and Accountability Act.
8. The City Council accepted the recommended Youth Commission Interview Subcommittee appointments to the Los Altos Youth Commission for FY 23/24.
9. The City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an amendment to the agreement with IMPEC Group for janitorial services in the amount of \$839,232 for two years on behalf of the City.

10. The City Council adopted a Resolution approving the allocation of the City's Transportation Development Act (TDA) funding to the Hetch Hetchy Path Enhancements and Access Improvements Project.
11. The City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an amendment to the agreement with Grassroots Ecology in the total amount of \$191,000 for a two-year term (\$95,500 per year) to manage and restore Redwood Grove Nature Preserve.
12. The City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a three-year agreement, totaling \$225,000, for orchard maintenance with the Orchard Commons Committee.
13. The City Council adopted a Resolution repealing Resolution No. 2019-30 regarding the Open Government Policy.
14. The City Council continued the appeal of the Planning Commission's Decision on the Design Review and Variance Applications SC22-0029 & V23-0002 at 5790 Arboretum Drive to September 26, 2023.
15. The City Council adopted an ordinance adopting by reference the 2021 International Property Maintenance Code with certain local amendments and found that the ordinance is exempt from CEQA pursuant to the provisions of Section 15061(b)(3) of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
16. The City Council directed the Los Altos Library Patio Project to the Development Services Director for review and necessary approval.
17. The City Council introduced and waived further reading of an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Los Altos Adding Chapter 11.15 to Title 11 Miscellaneous Property Regulations of the Los Altos Municipal Code Creating a Standalone Chapter for Leaf Blower Regulations. Second reading and adoption tentatively scheduled for July 11, 2023.
18. The City Council introduced and waived further reading of an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Los Altos Adding Chapter 11.14 Mechanical Equipment to Title 11 Miscellaneous Property Regulations of the Los Altos Municipal Code. Second reading and adoption tentatively scheduled for July 11, 2023.
19. The City Council provided direction on letters regarding SB 423 and SB 4.
