

#### City of Los Altos: 2015 Downtown Planning Survey

June 2015

The City of Los Altos commissioned Godbe Research to conduct a tracking survey of residents with the following research objectives:

- Gauge resident satisfaction with downtown Los Altos;
- Assess attitudes and perceptions about various aspects of downtown Los Altos, and parking in particular;
- Gauge resident preferences for recent development and future directions of downtown;
- Compare 2015 data with similar data from the 2012 survey; and
- Identify any differences in opinions due to demographic and/or behavioral characteristics.






#### Q1. Satisfaction with Downtown Los Altos




# Q2. Reasons for Satisfaction or Dissatisfaction with Downtown (n=401)




#### Q3. Frequency of Visiting Downtown Los Altos




#### Q4. Importance of a Convenient Connection Between Downtown and Community Center




#### Q5. Preferences for Connection Between Downtown and Community Center (n=299)



2012 - Q21. Comparison of Opinions on Office and Housing Development in Downtown Los Altos (Q21; n=413)






#### Q10. Opinion on Changing Building Regulations to Allow 3 or More Story Buildings (n=245)


## Q11. Perceptions of Individual Developments (n=401)









### Q15. Areas of Potential Concern in Downtown (n=401)



#### Q16. Comparison of Opinions About Focus of Downtown Los Altos (n=401)


