SUBJECT: Traffic Safe Community Network

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive information regarding Traffic Safe Community Network and discuss the desire to assign representative to attend their meetings

BACKGROUND

The Santa Clara County Public Health Department coordinates the Traffic Safe Communities Network (TSCN) to address traffic safety challenges in the county. TSCN is a unique collaborative of traffic safety stakeholders, including representatives from law enforcement, engineering, public health, injury prevention, elected officials, education, judicial system, emergency medical services, bicycle and pedestrian safety advocacy groups, and other interested community organizations. The combined efforts of TSCN's members have generated innovative projects that have contributed to the countywide reduction in motor vehicle crashes and improvements in bicycle and pedestrian safety.

DISCUSSION

It was suggested that the new Complete Streets Commission considers sending a representative to attend TSCN meetings. It is a good opportunity to learn about how other communities manage their transportation challenges. The meetings are typically held during the day in City of San Jose.
