**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS**

1. Senate Bill 743 – Vehicle Miles Traveled Methodology for Transportation Impacts  
City of Los Altos Planning Division is currently developing a policy to adopt Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) as a method to evaluate transportation impacts within the City. Michelle Hunt from Hexagon Transportation Consultants presented the item for the commission.
