SUBJECT: Transportation CIP Quarterly Update

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive Quarterly Update on the Transportation - Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

### INTRODUCTION

The City of Los Altos – Transportation CIP includes infrastructure projects focused on pavement, traffic signal, and bicycle-pedestrian facility improvements. During the Fiscal Year 2020-21 ending on June 30, 2021, the City has been focused on development of a new Complete Streets Master Plan (CSMP) project to help guide expenditures on future CIP projects. In addition, the City's various Pavement CIP-related projects are typically aligned, where feasible, to help implement recommended projects in the CSMP to help advance the deployment of bicycle-pedestrian facilities.

This quarterly update on the City's CIP Program is intended to identify the City's planned projects for the upcoming Fiscal Year 2021-22 beginning on July 1, 2021.

## BACKGROUND

The Transportation CIP Program includes annual projects, such as pavement maintenance (resurfacing and microsurfacing) and traffic calming, that fund either design and/or construction of improvements citywide or at isolated locations (e.g., sidewalk gap closure project). The overall CIP also includes projects for other city programs, such as facilities, parks, and water/wastewater.

The Fiscal Year 2021-22 CIP program was approved by the City Council on June 22, 2021.

## DISCUSSION

Exhibit A identifies the proposed Fiscal year 2021-22 CIP projects and their current status. Several projects are pending the completion of the CSMP project including the Safe Routes to School – School Improvement Map implementation program and projects based on priority ranking through the Annual Bicycle/Pedestrian Access Improvements project.
