3. <u>SC20-0016 – Via Builders – 16 Middlebury Lane</u>

Design review for an addition to the first and second stories to an existing two-story residence. The project includes adding 648 square feet at the first story and 278 square feet to the second story. *Project Planner: Golden*

Senior Planner Golden presented the staff report recommending approval of design review application SC20-0016 subject to the listed findings and conditions.

Project architect Jonathan Fales of Via Builders and project manager Ralph Salviano presented and answered Commissioner questions.

• Modify Condition #3 to preserve Tree #4 (Tulip tree). The applicant will work with the Planning Division staff to evaluate the feasibility of retaining tree #4, the Tulip tree.

4. <u>SC20-0021 – Terry J Martin, AIA – 1024 Highlands Circle</u>

Design review for first and second story additions to an existing one-story house. The project will include an addition of 422 square feet at the first story and 677 square feet at the second story. *Project Planner: Gallegos*

Associate Planner Gallegos presented the staff report recommending approval of design review application SC20-0021 subject to the listed findings and conditions.

Project architect, Terry Martin, AIA presented for the property owners and answered Commissioner questions.

• The applicant will work with City staff to revise the stair towers to be more integrated with the overall design of the new house.

5. <u>SC21-0002 – Walter Chapman – 270 Sunkist Lane</u>

Design review for a second story addition to a one-story house. The project will include a 313 square feet addition at the second story. The project includes a 604 square-foot attached accessory dwelling unit, which is not part of the design review application. *Project Planner: Gallegos*

Associate Planner Gallegos presented the staff report recommending approval of design review application SC21-0002 subject to the listed findings and conditions.

Project designer, Walter Chapman, presented the project to the Design Review Commission.

Property owner, Chris Kolstad, gave a presentation that explained how the project had minimal privacy impacts to the neighbors. He pledged to work with the rear yard neighbor to address any potential and future privacy concerns with the second-floor addition.

<u>Public Comment</u> The neighbor to the rear, the Kaftan family, stated some privacy concerns with light pollution and noise so close to their ADU.

The neighbor at 279 Alicia Way had a concern about landscape screening being installed.

<u>Action</u>: Upon a motion by Commissioner Harding, seconded by Commissioner Kirik, the Commission approved design review application SC21-0002 subject to the staff report findings and conditions.
