James offered to do some research on working with the city to build and/or link to the website. Committee members also brainstormed ideas on information the site could include as well as maintaining the site. Other areas of interest include: creeks, green building, renewable energies and energy conservation, air quality, smart building construction, trees, pest management policy and hazardous household waste.

Orr reported on the Palo Alto Regional Water Quality Control Plant and on a proposal to change disinfection system from chemicals to UV light. She also distributed a report on rate increases.
