Their comments included placing an emphasis on making the assumptions clear, emphasizing the risk factors involved including rising health care costs, increases in storm drain maintenance/improvement needs, and fire service costs. Commenter noted a need to be cautious in the first few years of the forecast and noted a need to highlight a range of conclusions, pessimistic – optimistic, to illustrate the range of possibilities for the reader.
