SUBJECT: Discuss noise issues at Woodland Library

RECOMMENDATION:

Discuss possible solutions to recommend to County and City staff to be considered within the appropriate guidelines and process

BACKGROUND

At the January 9, 2020 Library Commission meeting, Commissioner Wheeler indicated that several senior patrons of the Woodland Library expressed concern about the noise levels. The Infrastructure Subcommittee consisting of Commissioners Bedard, Gee and Wheeler presented several proposed solutions at the February 13, 2020 Library Commission meeting. Those solutions included building a teen room, or installing a soundproof/glass wall. The Commission decided to agendize a discussion of the noise issues at Woodland and the proposed solutions to further evaluate what might be possible.

DISCUSSION

City staff will provide a brief overview of City Council's strategic priorities for 2020 and beyond, and the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) to provide background information on guidelines and process.
