Informational Items

- Rose:
 - Open+ contract has now been signed for the Woodland branch
 - San Jose Public Library (SJPL) Open+ implementation will be at the Village Square branch , 4001 Evergreen Village Square, and the key SJPL contact is Michelle Amores
 - Rose and Jennifer have connected with Michelle Amores regarding SJPL's Open+ implementation, which was originally planned to launch in October 2021. Library staff will follow up with SJPL to find out details about the Village Square launch and how lessons learned may help with the Woodland Branch implementation

- Julie:
 - Has reached out to a prominent Los Altos real estate owner/management company regarding private-public space opportunities. Waiting to hear back.
 - Other possible avenues discussed by the team include Chamber of Commerce, Los Altos Village Association

Decisions

- Focus of subcommittee will be on the big project--private-public space to showcase opportunities for a future, redeveloped library, as this would require a concerted effort of multiple team members
